New Initiatives = New Hope FOR HOMELESS CHILDREN



FOR FAMILIES FACING HOMELESSNESS, IT ISN'T JUST ABOUT FINDING A HOME.

Families struggling to find permanent housing are forced to cope with complications such as a lack of adequate education, diminishing job options and the need for high-quality childcare. For over 20 years, Horizons for Homeless Children (HHC) has provided comprehensive support for homeless parents, high quality early education for their children and opportunities for homeless families to break the cycle of homelessness.

Every day, HHC helps homeless children and families expand their horizons so that they can achieve success in the future. And every day, we refine our statewide programs and services to ensure that this goal is met. This year, the Edgerley Family Community Children's Center (CCC) in Roxbury was awarded accreditation by the National Association for the Education of Young Children (NAEYC). All three of our CCCs have now earned NAEYC accreditation, a distinction granted to only 15% of preschools in the US. Together, the three CCCs prepare 175 young minds each week for academic achievement in kindergarten and beyond.

This year saw the implementation of two new initiatives designed to extend HHC's impact on the families and children we serve. Through the **Family Partnerships Program**, continued support is offered to families who have moved from shelter to housing outside the CCCs' catchment area, facilitating access to early education programs, connecting families to community resources and conducting regular home visits to ensure the sustained success of newly-stabilized families.

In tandem with Family Partnerships, the new **Evaluation and Innovation Program** allows HHC to systematically, longitudinally and efficiently evaluate our programming. The data collected informs us on our progress and allows us to enrich our programming and help guide service providers across the country on how to best help this vulnerable population. The process of evaluation continues after families find permanent housing, in an effort to measure the long term impacts of HHC programs. HHC is particularly interested in monitoring the progress of families as they work towards social and economic self-sufficiency and in the continued growth and development of their children as they enter the public school system. The anticipated outcome here is that our children are ready to learn and thrive in school as a result of their enrollment at HHC.

DURING FY11

- + 270 children were served in the three CCCs
- + 47 families secured permanent housing
- + 22 more parents enrolled in school/college
- + 18 more parents found employment

For families like Victoria and her son Jonathan, HHC's wrap-around services meant the difference between a stable new home and slipping back into homelessness. This year, Victoria was offered a Section 8 housing voucher. She was excited about the prospect of her own apartment in a neighborhood where Jonathan could play outside safely, but nervous about making the move to a new area alone. The lack of a support system was one factor that led to homelessness for Victoria, but thanks to the support of HHC's Family Advocates and comprehensive services, she did not face the task of securing her family alone. Horizons for Homeless Children was, and continues to be, with her and her child every step of the way.





A SHELTER, A PLAYSPACE,
A Difference, A Future

No one will ever claim that a homeless shelter is an ideal place for a child. But in more than 140 shelters across Massachusetts, there is a place, stocked with books and puzzles, train sets, doll houses, construction paper and Legos®, where children who reside there with their parents can learn, play and imagine.

Horizons for Homeless Children's (HHC) Playspace Programs work with 2,200 children every week. For those children, that means the chance to escape the turmoil of shelter life and instead focus on preparing imaginary meals, constructing ABC-block towers or sounding out letters with the help of a Playspace Activity Leader (PAL) volunteer. It means the chance to be a kid, a release from the worry and pressure of homelessness that even a two-year-old can experience.

Our partners at shelters where Playspaces are located provide overwhelmingly positive feedback regarding the impact the space can have on children living there. Nicole Lussier, Program Director of Open Pantry Teen Parent Program in Springfield, summed up the effect that a simple place to play has on homeless children:

"The Playspace here at Open Pantry has made such a difference in the lives of so many children. It gives them a time to play and to get away from the stress of living in the shelter. They love their "PALs" and always greet them with a hug, take them by the hand and lead them upstairs to play. At the end of the shift, they come back downstairs singing songs and carrying crafts that they've made. The kids know that the Playspace is theirs, and they take pride and ownership of it."

In a Playspace, social and academic foundations for future success are established for today's homeless children. Children can explore their world, make friends and play pretend in a Playspace: the happy pursuits of a normal, developing child.

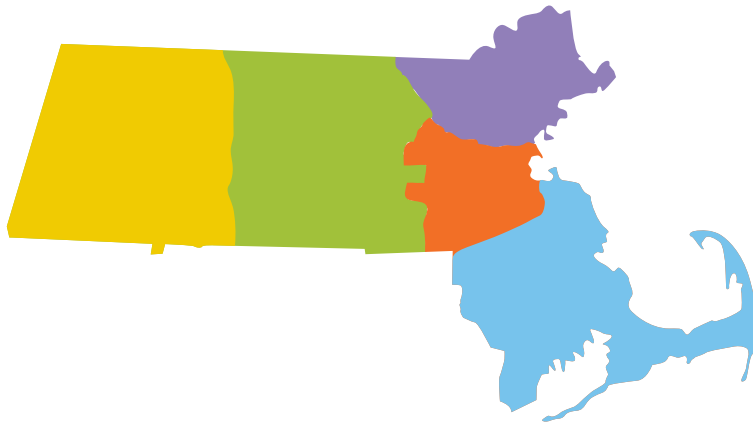
"I really can't say enough about the Playspace Programs," shares Nicole. "The program helps these kids learn and develop, to socialize, to be kind and learn to share. It helps them transition out of shelter to the next phase, and it shows them that there can be happiness in the midst of all the stress in their lives."

DURING FY11

- + 16 Playspaces were installed statewide
- + 28 PAL trainings took place across Massachusetts
- + A corps of 1,540 PALs volunteered each week in more than 140 Playspaces
- + 127,700 collective hours were spent volunteering with homeless young children in shelter-based Playspaces

Expanding Horizons ON A NATIONAL SCALE

At Horizons for Homeless Children (HHC), we believe that serving homeless children and families requires more than offering critical support services. It means advocating for this population, while sharing our knowledge and dedication on the issue of child and family homelessness. We understand systemic change takes concerted effort, and we seek to educate others throughout the nation who are learning to serve young homeless children as well.

This focus has established HHC as a thought leader on the challenges affecting homeless children and families and has gained the attention of lawmakers and authorities on homelessness across the nation.

To continue to establish ourselves at a national level, this year HHC hosted our 6th *Young Children Without Homes* National Conference in Washington, DC. Service providers from across the country gathered to hear the latest research and best practices on how to best support homeless children and families.

As part of the two-day conference, HHC followed knowledge with action by hosting an Advocacy Day on Capitol Hill. Participants urged elected officials to support initiatives that impact homeless children and families. Fully coordinated by HHC, including a comprehensive advocacy training, our first ever Capitol Hill Advocacy Day allowed conference participants to speak directly to lawmakers about the policies and regulations that affect the at-risk populations they serve.

Connecting with lawmakers and talks of further budget cuts incited a "healthy indignation" in these fledgling advocates,

and many expressed a desire to continue their efforts post-conference. Said HHC's Åsa Fanelli: "When the attendees are telling me, 'I know now I can write an email, or pick up the phone and call my legislator,' that's the ripple-effect we're looking for. That's how change is made."

Our own Policy and Advocacy team have made inroads with federal as well as Massachusetts lawmakers, speaking to them on the issues that deeply affect homeless families and sharing their stories with the people who can institute change. These efforts have been rewarded with an invitation to become a member of the Interagency Council on Housing and Homelessness Advisory Board, which grants HHC a seat at the table on conversations surrounding family homelessness.

As a nation, we're struggling with record numbers of citizens experiencing poverty and homelessness. As an agency, we hope to lead lawmakers and service providers in establishing the policies and practices that will best serve the hundreds of thousands of homeless children and families in the US. Together, we can expand the horizons, and brighten the futures, of American families experiencing homelessness.



The Campaign for Young Homeless Children

An estimated 1.6 million children are homeless in the United States each night. Half of them are under the age of six, a time of unprecedented human development. They need healthy opportunities to learn and to grow—to crawl, to toddle and to build a healthy foundation for lifelong success. Unfortunately, opportunities for learning are hard to come by when children are homeless.

This year, HHC launched The Campaign for Young Homeless Children, an effort devoted to the principle that all children deserve a fair chance to take their best step forward even when their families are on precarious footing.
